# What are Primary Care Networks?

-  PCNs are groups of clinicians from the NHS and voluntary organisations **sharing a vision** for how to improve the care of their population
-  **Groups of Practices working together** and with other local health and care providers( including primary care, community services, social care and voluntary sector
-  **A defined patient population** of 30,000-50,000 people
-  **Providing care in different ways to match different people's needs,** including flexible access to advice and support for 'healthier' sections of the population, and joined up care for those with complex conditions



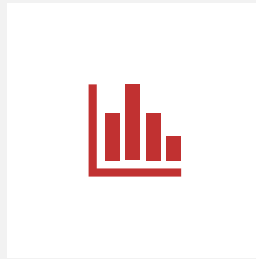

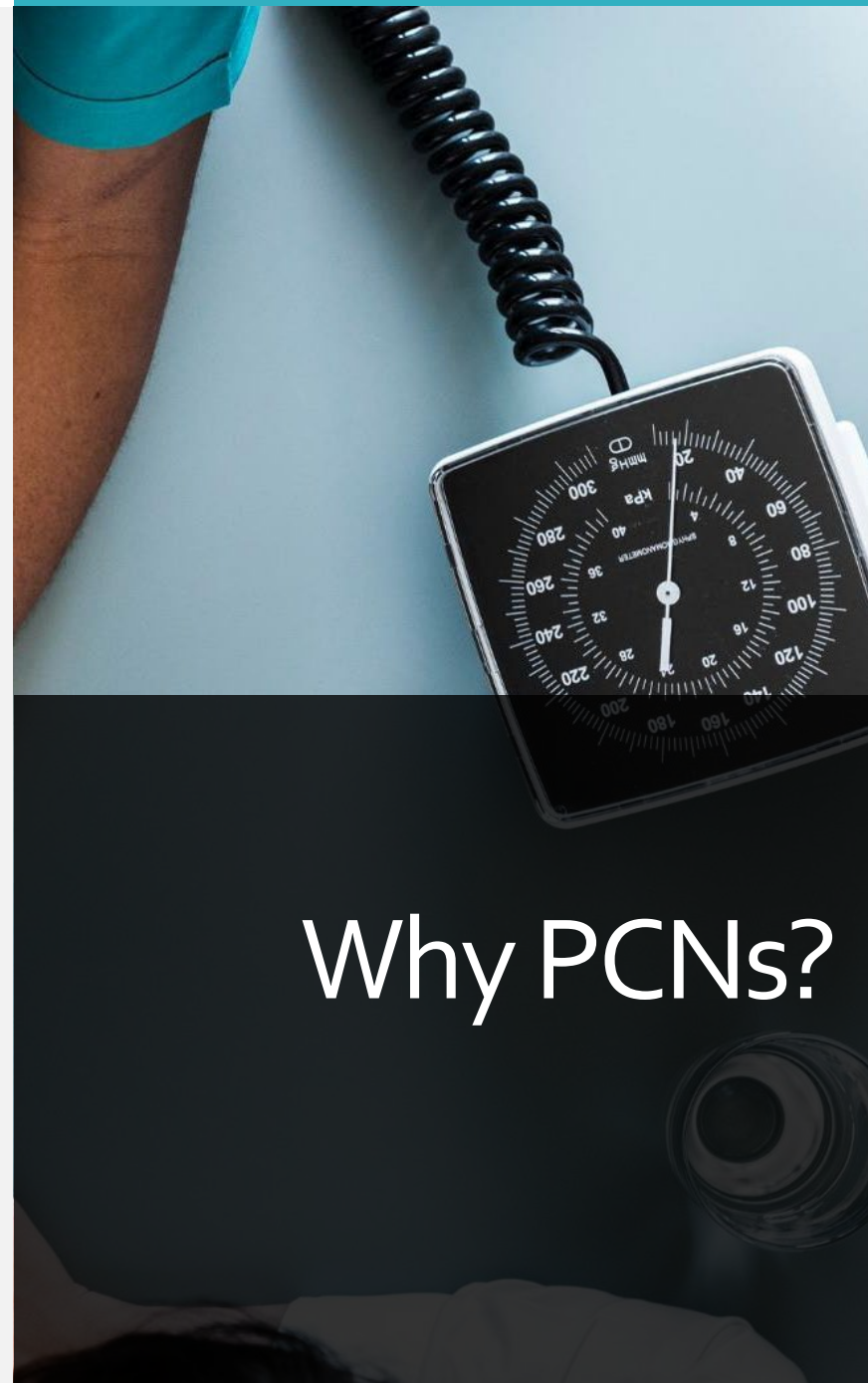

# What will PCNs do?

-  Focus on **prevention and personalised care**, supporting patients to make informed decisions and look after their own health by connecting them with the full range of statutory and voluntary services.
-  Use **data and technology to assess population health needs and health inequalities**, to inform, design and deliver practice and population scale care models; to support clinical decision making, and monitor performance and variation to inform continuous service improvement.
-  Make the best use of **collective resources across practices** and other local health and care providers to allow greater resilience, more sustainable workload and access to a larger range of professional groups.

# What does this mean in practice?

Under the Directed Enhanced Services (DES) contract, PCNs will deliver **extended hours services**, as well as NHS Long Term Plan commitments set out in **seven** new network service requirements:



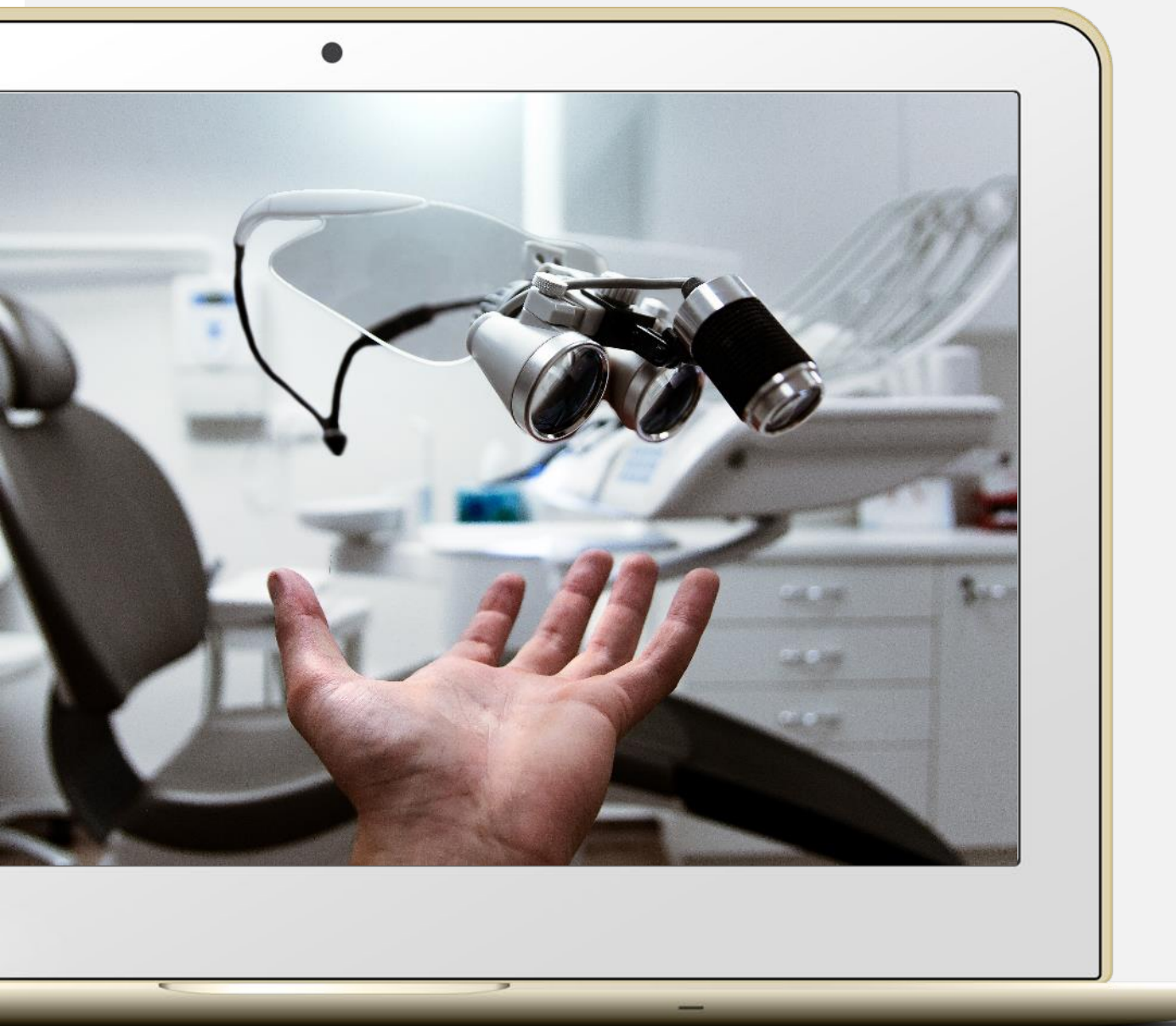
## From April 2020:

- Structured medications review (SMR) and optimisation
- Enhanced health in care homes
- Anticipatory care (with community services)
- Personalised care
- Supporting early cancer diagnosis



## From April 2021:





- Cardiovascular disease diagnosis and prevention
- Locally agreed action to tackle inequalities

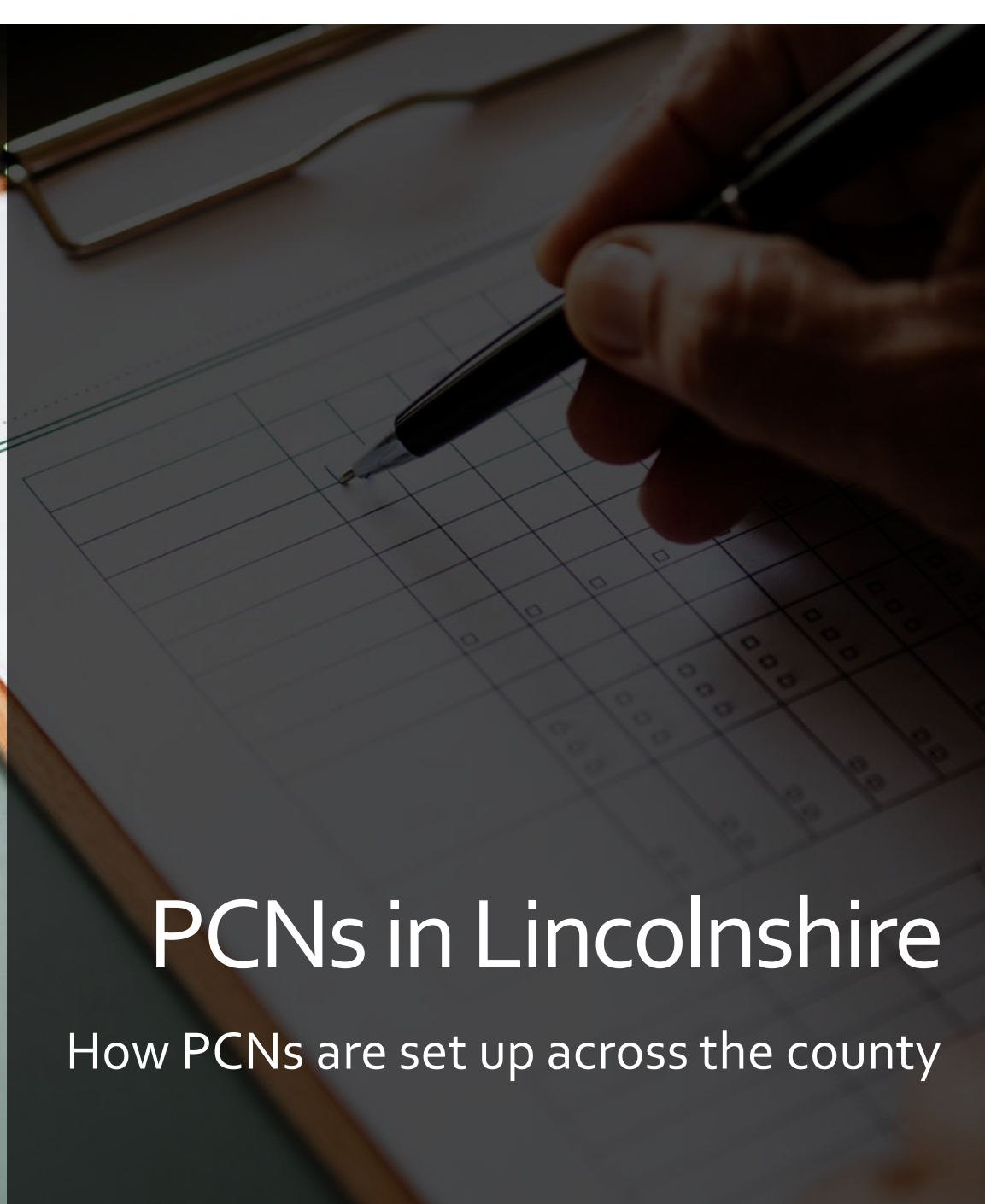
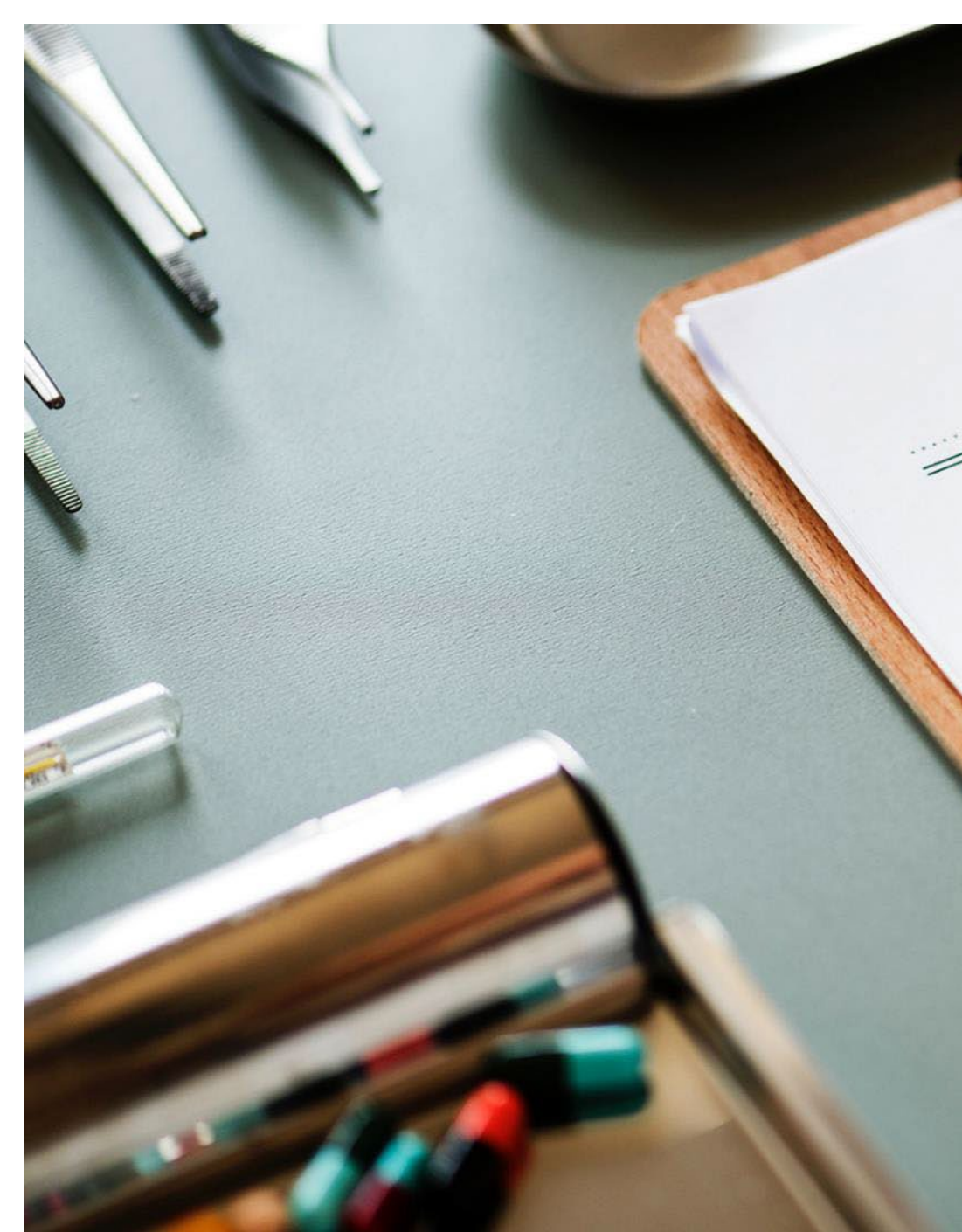


## For patients...

-  More **co-ordinated services** where they do not have to repeat their story multiple times
-  Access to a **wider range of professionals in the community**, so they can get access to the people and services they need in a single appointment
-  Appointments that **work around their lives** with shorter waiting times and different ways to get treatment and advice including digital, telephone-based and face-to-face
-  **Personalisation** and a focus on prevention and living healthily, recognising what matters to them and their individual strengths, needs and preferences

## For the healthcare system...

-  Better **co-operation and collaboration** between organisations, providing more co-ordinated services
-  Provision of **more services in the community setting**, allowing patients to access these locally and reducing the burden on more expensive secondary care
-  A shift to a **population-focused approach** to decision-making and resource allocation across the healthcare system drawing on primary care expertise as central partners
-  **Greater resilience** in primary care, as this acts as the foundation of integrated systems

 It is **vital** for community pharmacy teams to be fully engaged in the work of PCNs

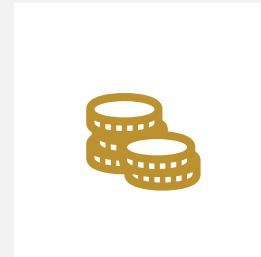
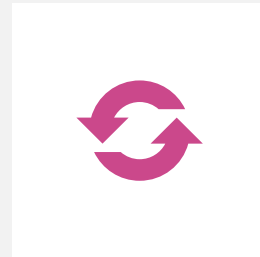
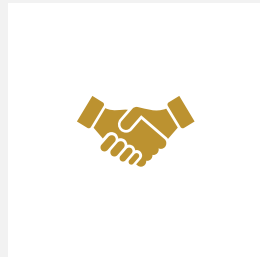
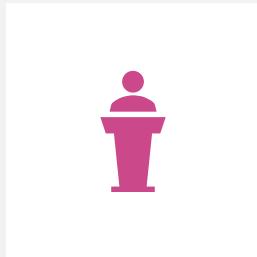
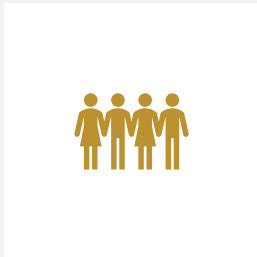
- To optimise our provision of services to patients
- And because the future development of local services (and our role in them) will be influenced by PCNs

It's why the PCN domain has been included in the Pharmacy Quality Scheme!

 This includes identifying a local **community pharmacy representative** to act as a lead for the sector in each PCN

# PCN Community Pharmacy Leads

PCN leads are determined by community pharmacies in each PCN; **they are not appointed by the LPC**

# Confirming your PCN lead

## Only one nominee

-  Community Pharmacy members or representatives of the PCN should accept the nominee by agreement in the room

## More than one nominee

-  Simple paper ballot
  - Votes allocated based on number of contracts held within the PCN area
  - Votes will be counted and the PCN lead determined

-  Work with the PCN lead to advance community pharmacy in the area
